## 2008 Summer Recreation (Full-Day) Camps

*For children Ages 7-12 • Financial Aid is available – please call for more information*

**REGISTRATION:** Pre-registration is required. A \$25, non-refundable deposit is required to reserve a spot for each session; all balances are due two weeks prior to the start of camp. Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Each camp has a limit of 40 children.

**OPEN HOUSE:** Thursday, April 3; 4pm – 7pm at the Gilliam Building, 77 Reads Way, New Castle, DE. Staff will be on hand to accept registrations and answer any questions you may have.

**LUNCH / SNACKS:** Campers must bring their own lunch and morning and afternoon snacks each day.

**CAMP FORMAT:** Camps run from 9am – 4pm, Monday through Friday. Pre-care is available at all sites from 7:30am. After-care is available at the Conrad, Delcastle, Garfield, and Talley sites till 5:30pm.

**ACTIVITIES:** Daily camp programming includes arts/crafts, fitness and nature activities, sports games and contests, and recreational and educational programming.

**FIELD TRIPS:** Camp includes a swimming trip and one field trip per week (no additional cost). Children will be transported to sites that offer ice skating, roller skating and swimming, and to programs at Brandywine Creek State Park, Camden Aquarium, Cape Henlopen State Park, Carousel Park, Franklin Institute, and more. The field trips at each camp location will vary, and not all camp locations will travel to all of the listed program sites.

### CAMP LOCATIONS

**Brader Elementary School** (107 Four Seasons Parkway, Newark) ..... **Camp Code BR**  
Located off Four Seasons Parkway in Glasgow, this school site is within easy walking distance to the communities of Four Seasons, Thornwood, Pencader Village, Eagle Trace and Waters Edge.

**Conrad School of Sciences** (formerly Conrad Middle School - 201 Jackson Avenue, Wilmington) ..... **Camp Code CR**  
Located off Boxwood Road in the Newport / Richardson Park area, this camp location was moved from its previous site in Banning Park. The park will still be used for many camp activities along with the school's gym, classroom, and fields.

**Delcastle Recreation Area** (2920 Duncan Road, Wilmington) ..... **Camp Code DC**  
This camp is housed in the Police Sub-station on the grounds of the New Castle County's award winning Delcastle Recreation Area. Daily sports programming is featured at this site that also offers a large playground, plenty of hiking and open space activity and a street hockey rink.

**Garfield Park Activity Center** (26 Karlyn Drive, New Castle) ..... **Camp Code GP**  
Located in the New Castle County Activity Center in the Garfield Park PAL Building, this location has a playground area and sports field as well as an indoor gymnasium, air-conditioned activity areas, and a computer lab.

**Redding Middle School** (201 New Street, Middletown) ..... **Camp Code MT**  
This camp was previously located at St. Andrews School. New Castle County partners with the Town of Middletown to run this camp location. The outdoor programming theme of our camps will still be implemented at this site and addition of the gymnasium and classroom space will allow us to expand our programs, especially during inclement weather.

**Talley Day Park** (815 Wilson Road, Wilmington) ..... **Camp Code TD**  
Located in the former Streed Farm House in New Castle County's Talley Day Park, this unique camp site offers a paved, wooded trail, large playground, plenty of open space for recreation and nature hikes, and programming at the Brandywine Hundred Regional Library.
